- 1. Every student must read all the instructions in this prospectus carefully.
- 2. The student should check whether he/she is eligible to take admission in the desired program. Otherwise University will not take any responsibility of it.
- 3. Following application forms will not be accepted.
 - a) In other formats, with error, incomplete or inadequately written*.
 - b) Application forms without necessary documents.
- 4. Self-attested photo copies of original documents should be attached with application form. Following original documents must be submitted, at the time of admission:
 - a) Leaving Certificate of the college.
 - b) Mark sheet of the last appeared exam and 10th, 12th, and mark sheets of part 1,2,3, of graduate degree with true copies.
 - c) Migration Certificate for other universities.
 - d) Character Certificate
 - e) Eligibility Certificate
 - f) Caste Certificate for reserved category students and Caste Validity Certificate issued by the competent authorities.
- 5. No new applicant will be admitted after the declaration of the closing date by Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.
- 6. The names of the enrolled students will be displayed on the notice board.
- 7. Admitted students should follow the rules about the discipline of the university.
- 8. In case of the violation of the rule / rules, admission of the involved student will be cancelled by the head of the concerned department,
- 9. In case the admission is cancelled, student has to submit the receipt of the fees. Then only the leaving certificate of the concerned student will be returned else bonafied certificate will be issued.
- 10. All the admissions in Post Graduate Teaching Departments will be processed according to the prevailing guidelines and rules of Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.
- 11. All the rights are with the head of the departments, to bring any change and instructions about the change/s thus made, will be displayed on the notice board accordingly. *
- 12. The instructions of the Government as well as the University will be applicable for the admission process from time to time.

V. Semester Pattern and Credit Grade System:

- i) The P.G.Programme M.A., M.Sc., M.Com. and MBA shall be of two academic years consisting of Four Semesters with University Examinations at the end of each semester.
- ii) Minimum Marks for passing will be 40%. Candidate has to pass in Theory (external assessment) and Internal assessment taking together except some courses.
- iii) Credit Grade System: One Credit means One period of one-hour duration by which the course work is measured.
 - Grade is a measure of performance quality. At the end of each semester, a student is awarded a letter grade. It is transformation of actual marks secured by a student in a course / Paper. Grade letters are O, A, B, C, D, E, F.
- iv) In credit and grade point system, the assessment of individual courses in the concerned examination will be on the basis of marks only, but marks shall later be converted in to grades by some mechanism wherein overall performance of the learner can be reflected after considering the credit points for any given course. However, the overall evaluation shall be designated in terms of grades.
- v) SGPA is indicative of performance of a student in a given semester. Semester Grade Point Average shall be calculated for individual semester.
- vi) CGPA Cumulative Grade Point Average is indicative of the overall academic performance of a students in all the courses registered up to and including the latest completed semester. It shall be calculated for the entire programme by considering all the semesters taken together.

It is available on the University website www.unigug.ac.in the directions of concerning faculty.

VII. Conditions of Eligibility and ATKT Rules

A) For Admission to M.A. part I Courses in the Faculty of Humanities:

- i) Persons who have passed B.A. Examination of any recognized university, or an Examination recognized as equivalent thereto.
- ii) Persons who are graduates of Gondwana University, Gadchiroli or an Examination recognized as equivalent thereto in a faculty other than the Arts Faculty & have subsequently passed the B.A. examination with any of the subjects English, Sociology, History as additional Subject will be eligible for admission to the M.A. Programme.

B) For admission to the M.Sc. Part I Courses in the Faculty of Science & Technology:

Persons who have passed the B.Sc. Examination of the any recognized University, are eligible for admission to the M.Sc. Part-I Courses in a subject offered by them for their examination, provided they have secured an aggregate of not less than 45% marks at the B.Sc. Examination.



C) For admission to the M.Com. Part I Courses in Commerce & Management :

A candidate shall have passed B.Com., B.Com. (Computer Application) or B.B.A. Degree Examination of any recognized University.

VIII. General Instructions

- I) On admission to the Department, a student becomes liable to pay tuition fee for the whole session. If a student leaves the Department for any reason after admission, he will not be exempted from payment of any part of the tuition fee.
- ii) Unless the first instalment of the fees as mentioned in the rate of fees is paid in full, students will not be allowed in the classes* and their admission will stand cancelled, if payment is not made within four days from the date of admission.
- iii) The second Instalment of fees shall be paid by 15th December of the current academic year. Default in of second instalment of fees shall render the student liable for a fine of Rs. 10/- per calendar month.
- iv) Every applicant for admission other than the one from Gondwana University, shall produce a migration certificate signed by the Registrar of the University or Board from which he migrates before the expiry of term and pay an immigration fees as per the directions issued by Gondwana University. In case of failure to submit the Migration Certificate the admission shall cancelled.
- v) Persons not already enrolled as students of Gondwana University shall pay the University Enrolment fee of Rs.125/- at the time of admission to the Department.
- vi) For Study Tours prescribed in certain subject, students will have to bear their own expenses.
- vii) a) No student shall be admitted the Post-Graduate Examination unless he produces the Diploma or Degree. The Degree student migrating from another University must produce the Diploma or his Degree by 15th September of the current year.
 - b) A student admitted to a Department shall be required to maintain his/her attendance during the regular course of study which means at least seventy-five percent of lectures delivered in the subject of the examination and in the case of where practical work is prescribed, the completion of seventy -five percent of such work, the written examination.
 - c) Students who are awarded Scholarships or Free Studentships by the University or State/Central Government should attend all the classes without fail, if they are unable to attend them on any day, they must send an application countersigned by their Local Guardian and obtain permission. Negligence in this respect may entitle for revoking the facility of the fee/Scholarship or Free Studentship in whole or in the part.
 - d) Every student shall do the tutorial and internal assessment work and appear at such Examination as per the provision of Gondwana Univeristy, Gadchiroli. A student who does not comply with these directions and does not obtain the minimum marks may not be admitted to the University Examination.
 - e) Students are required to keep the office of the Department informed about their address in Gadchiroli and also permanent addresses. If Gadchiroli is not their permanent residence. Change of address must be duly communicated to the office. In the failure of which, office will not be responsible for the non-delivery of a communication, on account of any mistake in the address as recorded in the register.
 - f) Other information regarding Examination will be found in the University Directions, Statues and Ordinances.



IX. Hostel for Boys and Girls

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

A) Allotment of Occupancy:

- 1. Allotment of Seats will be made randomly using suitable mechanism taking into account the response to Online Hostel Enquiry Form.
- 2. Certain seats shall be reserved for Reserve Category /Weaker section/ International students as per the policy of University.
- 3. The admission and continued stay in the Hostel depend upon the academic performance and on good behaviour and conduct.
- 4. Room once allotted to a student for an academic year will not be changed, except on special situations with the permission of the Warden.

B) Admission Confirmation:

- 1. Hostel Accommodation is available to the Students who have secured admission in a particular Post Graduate Teaching Department of University.
- 2. The student has to pay the requisite Hostel Fees at the time of confirmation of admission.
- 3. Student seeking admission in Hostels must apply online/offline within the stipulated time along with the following documents.
 - i) Fee Receipt of admission
 - ii) Date of Birth Certificate
 - iii) Proof of Residence/Domicile Certificate.
 - iv) Three self-attested recent colour passport size photographs.
 - v) Documents supporting to reserve category status. (if applicable)
 - vi) Photograph of Local Guardian with residential address i.e. self-attested photocopy of any one of the following :
 - (a) Voter I Card (b) Electricity / Water bills (c) Passport (d) Aadhaar card
- 4. At the time of admission to the hostel, every student shall sign an undertaking to the effect that he shall follow the Hostel Policy, Rules and Code of Conduct as notified from time to time and counter signed by his/her parents/Legal guardians/Local guardians. In case of breach of any Rules & Regulation, he shall be liable for the disciplinary action.
- 5. Student shall produce a Medical Certificate from Registered Medical Practitioner. Students are required to disclose all past medical history at the time of admission to the Hostel Authority.
- 6. Students are required to sign an Anti-Ragging Undertaking as per the Guidelines of the UGC, at the time of admission to hostel.
- 7. Students cannot vacate or cease using the hostel facility during the academic year. If they do so, the fees shall be forfeited the hostel Fees paid by them for the entire academic year and no claim for refund shall be entertained.
- 8. If any student provides any misleading or false statement or information in the hostel admission form, his admission shall be liable to be cancelled. On such cancellation, the student shall not be entitled to refund Hostel Fees.



2. Fees Structure & Payment Schedule

Student, who has been admitted in the hostel, should pay prescribed fee completely of the academic year. If student desires to discontinue his/her admission in the hostel, he/she shall be allowed to do so, and 80% of fees will be refunded to the student. He/she can cancel admission within 15 days from the date of admission in the hostel. Thereafter, no refund is permissible.

General Instructions (Hostels):

The Post Graduate Teaching Department of Gondwana University Gadchiroli has introduced the following scheme for the new students taking admission in the Hostel during academic year 2023-24.

- 1. Admission fees for the hostel shall be waived off.
- 2. Allotment of the hostel accommodation will be as per the directives from the competent authorities from time to time
- 3. All students of the hostels are required to pay Rs. 500/-(Refundable) as caution Money on confirmation. The caution money will be refunded to the students at the end on vacating hostel. On account of breakage or damage to the hostel property, the compensatory amount will be deducted from the caution money. Student leaving the hostel during or after completion of the academic year should claim the refund of caution money within two years from the date of vacating. If failed to claim within given period of time, the remaining amount of caution money shall be deposited in the account of Student Welfare Fund (SWF).

3. Facilities

A) Medical Facilities:

- 1. The health services are made available to the residents by the University within the Campus. Doctors for Girls and Boys are available round the clock.
- 2. In case of a medical emergency, a resident will be taken to the nearest hospital and the local guardian shall be duly informed.
- 3. The local guardian will have to take charge thereafter and the entire responsibility for treatment and related expenses will be borne by the parents/local guardian. Hence the contact/phone number must be confirmed by the Resident frequently.

B) Wi-Fi & Electricity Backup:

Wi-Fi Facility is available. Uninterrupted power supply round the clock is also available to facilitate academic commitment.

C) Banking Facilities:

The Bank is available in the University Campus. The residents are advised to take good care of their bank pass book/ cheque books, etc. and not to keep cash or other valuables in their rooms. The authorities will not be responsible for any losses.



D) Health-Related Facilities:

- a) Dedicated Public Health Centre
- b) Ambulance Service in Emergency
- c) University Canteen Service

E) Security:

- 1. Round-the-clock security will be provided with security guards at main gate of the Hostel.
- 2. Entire Campus is under CCTV Surveillance.

4. Furniture & Fixtures:

- 1. The student will take possession of the room after signing the inventory of the furniture, electrical and other items in the room.
- 2. On allocation of the hostel room, the hostellers will be provided with the essential furniture and fixtures. The students should ensure that such furniture and fixtures are maintained in good condition.
- 3. Hostellers are required to hand over furniture and other materials in good condition when they change/ vacate the hostel room. Failing which the concerned student/s will be charged for the damaged furniture/ materials
- 4. Hostellers have to maintain their personal belonging on their risk including laptop/desktop.

5. Hostel Timings:

- 1. No hosteller will be allowed to stay in the hostel during class timings (09.00 am to 04.00 pm).
- 2. The hostellers are required to check-in the hostel premises before 9.00 pm. whenever the hosteller(s) leave the hostel premises, they need to notify in the register kept with the warden/security withoutfail. Silence hour is between 10.30 pm and 06.00 am on all days. Violation of the same will result in disciplinary action against the errant hosteller.

6. Hostel Attendance:

All hostellers should report to hostel before 09:00 pm. Attendance will be taken at sharp 09:30 pm every night. Hosteller has to sign the attendance register besides biometric attendance. Any late comer will have to sign in separate register.

7. Parents / Visitor:

- 1. Parents / Authorized visitors of the hostellers are permitted to visit their wards with the permission of the hostel authorities in the Lobby in a time allotted.
- 2. No Parent / Guardian / Visitor or any person is allowed to stay with the hostellers in their rooms. However, with prior intimation to the concerned hostel authority, Guest Room can be booked on payment basis. This provision is subject to availability of the Guest Room.
- 3. No Parent / Guardian / Guests are permitted to stay in Boys or Girls Hostels.
- 8. Permission for Outing (Out Pass):
- 1. A hosteller, who wants to move outside the Hostel due to work, will be issued Out pass only after the receipt of SMS requesting permission (specifying duration of out pass and reason) sent from the registered mobile number of the parent/ authorized guardian.
- 2. Students, who wish to stay in Hostel or move outside the Hostel during teaching hours, should get special permission from HOD/Dean along with Parents/Guardians for the issue of out pass.
- 3. Hostellers will be permitted to go out of hostel with parents/guardians on holidays after obtaining due permission from the concerned hostel authority.



Vacation:

- 1. During notified vacations, students must remove all of their belongings from their allotted rooms in order to allow the hostel authorities to carry out maintenance work.
- 2. Students, who prefer to stay back in hostel during the end semester vacation for Internship/Professional Practice/Summer Term, etc., should take prior permission from the HOD/Dean of the concerned Department/School and hostel authorities. Accommodation during this period will be on payment basis and such payment shall be in addition the hostel fees paid /payable.

9. Cancellation & Refund Policty:

- 1. A student who wishes to get her admission cancelled must apply before two months in writing to the Warden with the application countersigned by her guardian/parent.
- 2. On cancellation of admission within three months of the date of admission, a student would be entitled to get the refund of fee as follows:
 - a) Hostel Annual Fees after deducting an amount which is equal to 1/10th of the Annual Fees per month for the period of stay in the Hostel.
 - b) No Claim for refund of Annual charges would be allowed after three months of the date of admission to the Hostel.

Residents are required to vacate their rooms within Seven days of their last University examination and hand over the keys of their rooms to the Warden/Attendant, failing which, they would not be admitted to the Hostel the following year even if otherwise eligible. The Registrar/Warden is authorized to remove their belongings in the room if any, and put an official lock.

Ragging within or outside of GUG Gadchiroli Campus is prohibited. Ragging is a Criminal Offence Punishable. Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside the University Campus will be punishable by Law Resulting in Imprisonment and / Penalty as per University Grants Commission Circulation No. F1-16 / 2009 (CPP II), dated September 2009 as per the order of Hon. Supreme court of India vide ref no.: In SLP No. 24295 of 2006 & Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 and Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging.

X. Fees for Casual Students

Fees payable by casual students if admitted to the P.G. Teaching Departments maintained by the University:

- (a) RS. 75/- p.m. where the student has to conduct practical's by using laboratory of the Department.
- (b) Rs. 60/- p.m. for other Departments.
- (c) Casual students shall also be required to pay caution Money of Rs.75/-

XI. Fees for Research Students

1. For the Humanities, Commerce and such other Faculties where practical work and field facilities are not involved, the fees payable shall be as prescribed by the University from time to time and students who are registered for Ph.D. in any of the Faculties where laboratory facilities are utilized, shall pay a refundable Caution Money of Rs.75/-.

The rates of fees prescribed by the university shall apply to all categories of students, viz.-Research students, Teachers doing research and also Casual Students admitted for research.



XII. Award of Tuition Fees and Examination Fees to Backward Class Students for the current Academic Year*

With a view to provide educational facilities amongst the backward classes, it has been the policy of the Government to provide free Education to Backward Classes, irrespective of age and income at all stages of education and in all types of recognized institutions during the current academic year, under the Backward Class welfare programme. The social welfare Department has continued the scheme of award of "Free Studentship" to Backward Classes which extends Free studentship Concession to all the Backward Class Students who come under the following categories:

- 1. The Backward Class Students who rejected the Government of India Scholarship on account of their parent's income beyond the prescribed limit.
- 2. The Students having one failure in the same standard.

For this purpose, the student is required to furnish full particulars in proper format and information to the Departments concerned to enable them to claim the fees from the Government.

a) Government of India Post-Matric Scholarship to the B. C. Students.

Govt. of India Post-Matric Scholarships to B. C. Students, the latest directives will be applicable for the above scholarship. After receipt of the same from the Govt. the same will be circulated to the Department.

b) Students' Aid Fund Scheme.

Needy students shall be eligible to get financial assistance to meet their tuition fees, examination fees, book, hostel, mess, clothing or medical expenses etc. under the Students' Aid Fund Scheme which will be provided in the form of reimbursement of the expenditure on different items and payment in cash will be restricted to the minimum. No Scholarship or stipends will be given from this fund.

c) Students' Medical Aid Fund Scheme:

Needy students shall be eligible to get financial assistance will be made available for major accidents, major diseases for medical expenses under this scheme in the form of the expenditure on different items and payment will be restricted to the minimum. No scholarship or stipends will be given from this fund.

d) Students Welfare Fund Scheme (As per the rules of the scheme):

Seminars / Workshops / Short term Research Project / JCT Awareness Programmes / Skill Training Programmes / Personality Development programmes / National Service Scheme / Earn and Learn Scheme.

e) Game & Sports Activities:

For all round development of the students, the sports facilities will be provided. The P.G.T. Department has spacious ground for playing various games. Students may participate in the Intercollegiate, Inter-university, Zonal and National level Game & Sports competitions.

f) Student's Council:

It is a body of students as per Gondwana University, Gadchiroli norms. The most important and awaited activity by University student's council is the cultural gathering Yuva Mahotsav; Research Festival Avishkar Inter-collegiate cultural competitions and many other personality development programmes by the Department of Student Development of the University.



g) Discipline and Code of Conduct:

- I. The conduct of student in the campus should not cause disturbance or inconvenience to other in any manner. Otherwise the students will have to face the disciplinary action. Student should strictly adhere to the Department timings.
- II. Students must appear for all the test examinations, Internal Assessment process of the concerning Department.
- III. Ragging in the campus is strictly prohibited. Anti- ragging code laid down by the Honourable Supreme court of India has made it criminal offence. FIR will be lodged against those who indulge in such activities.

h) Allocation of Seats:

The percentage of allocation of seats for various types of candidates i.e. for the Home University and University other than Home University shall be in accordance with the policy of the University for admission in various entry level of Post Graduate Courses.

There shall be reservation of seats in each place of learning for the candidates belonging to the Home University, subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time. This reservation shall be as per the following chart:

Note:

- i. The above reservation is exclusive of the number of students belonging to the above categories who secure admission on merit.
- ii. If any of the Backward class categories mentioned above, do not get the required number of candidates for the percentage(s) laid down, the seats so remaining vacant shall be filled in from among the candidates from the other reserved categories on inter-se-merit as per University Circular No. SCT/M/S/224, dated 28th June 2002.
- iii. The valid Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued by the competent authorities is essential for all categories of reservation except SC and ST candidates as per Govt. Circular No. dated 15th June, 2006.



- iv. Candidate claiming to, belong to the Backward Classes of the State must attach a certificate from the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate and the District Magistrate or the Executive Magistrate authorized by them in other areas, of Special Welfare Officer of Zilla Parishad or Special Welfare Officer of Bombay. If no certificate is produced it would be classified as Non-Backward.
- v. The admission of students from Reserved Category to the Post Graduate Courses will be made on merit basis, based on the marks obtained by them in qualifying examination, relaxed by 5% in the minimum percentage of marks.
- vi. Students should submit Govt. of India Scholarship forms at the time of admission.
- i) Reservation of seats for other category
- I. 3% seats will be reserved for the Physically Handicapped students as per university.
- ii. 5% seats will be reserved in Post Graduate Teaching Departments for Ex Serviceman /Military personal or their wards as per Govt. Resolution No. TCM 1204 (167 / 85) MC, dated 13-06-1985 and letter No. GA/D/G/745, dated 7 2-1986.
- j) Weightage / Deduction
- i) Weightage of marks for admission to the P.G.T. Department & College & allotment of seats for Sportsman /Woman vide University letter; No. गो.वि. /वि.मा.व. //51/2015 दि. 1/06/2015
- ii) Deduction of 1% of total aggregate marks prescribed for the whole examination at degree level in Science and for gap or attempt.

Note:

Abstract of Section 127 of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act 2016 regarding Disciplinary powers and Discipline among students is as under:

- 127.1) All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action in relation to the students of the university departments and institutions and colleges maintained by the university, shall vest in the Vice-Chancellor.
- (2) The Vice-Chancellor may, by an order, delegate all or any of his powers under sub-section (1), as he deems fit, to such other officer as he may nominate in that behalf.
- (3) The Vice-Chancellor may, in the exercise of his powers, by an order, direct that any student or students be expelled or rusticated for a specified period, or be not admitted to a course or courses of study in conducted college, institution or department of the university for a specified period, or be punished with fine, as prescribed by the university, or be debarred from taking an examination or evaluation conducted by the department, conducted college or institution maintained by the university for a specified period not exceeding five years or that the result of the student or students concerned in the examination or evaluation in which he or they have appeared, be cancelled:
 - Provided that, the Vice-Chancellor shall give reasonable opportunity of being heard to the student concerned, if expulsion is for a period exceeding one year.
- (4) Without prejudice to the powers of the Vice-Chancellor, the principals of conducted colleges, heads of university institutions and the heads of departments of the university shall have authority to exercise all such powers over the student in their respective charge as may be necessary for the maintenance of proper discipline.
- (5) Provisions as regards discipline and proper conduct for students of the university and the action to be taken against them for breach of discipline or misconduct, shall be as may be prescribed by the Statutes, which shall apply to the students of all its conducted colleges and university departments or institutions, affiliated colleges and recognized institutions.



- (6) Statutes relating to discipline and proper conduct for students, and the action to be taken against them for breach of discipline or misconduct, shall also be published in the prospectus of the university, affiliated college or recognized institution and every student shall be supplied with a copy of the same. The principals of the colleges and heads of the institutions, maintained by the university and affiliated colleges, may, prescribe additional norms of discipline and proper conduct, not inconsistent with the Statutes, as they think necessary and every student shall be supplied with a copy of such norms.
- (7) At the time of admission, every student shall sign a declaration to the effect that he submits himself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Vice-Chancellor and the other officers and authorities or bodies of the university and the authorities or bodies of the conducted colleges, affiliated colleges and recognized institutions, and shall observe and abide by the Statutes made in that behalf and in so far as they may apply, the additional norms made by the principals of conducted colleges and heads of university institutions and affiliated colleges.
- (8) All powers relating to disciplinary action against students of an affiliated college or recognized institution not maintained by the university, shall vest in the principal of the affiliated college or head of the recognized institution, and the provisions of the sub-sections (6) and (7) including the Statutes made thereunder, shall mutatis-mutandis apply to such colleges, institutions and students therein.
- Note: If any of the statement made in application form or any information supplied by the candidates in connection with his/her admission is later on at any time found to be false or incorrect his/her admission will be cancelled fees forfeited and he / she may be expelled from the department by the competent Authority and prosecuted, if deemed necessary.

General Instructions:

The Post Graduate Teaching Department of Gondwana University, Gadchiroli has introduced the following scheme for the new students taking admission in the academic year 2024-25

- 1. Admission fees for the fresher students of all faculties except M.B.A. shall be waived off
- 2. All students are required to register for the admission process by paying Rs. 25/- as registration fees.
- 3. All students of Chemistry, Physics and Computer Science are required to pay Rs. 500/- (refundable) as Caution Money.
- 4. Allotment of Admission will be as per the directives from the competent authorities from time to time.

XIV. UGC Regulation on Anti – Ragging

UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institution, 2009.

PREAMBLE:

In view of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 8.05.2009 and in consideration of the determination of the Central Government and the University Grants Commission to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging.

OBJECTIVE:

To eliminate ragging in all its forms from universities, deemed universities and other higher educational institutions in the country by prohibiting it under these Regulations, preventing its occurrence and punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided for in these Regulations and the appropriate law in force.

AFFIDAVIT BY STUDENTS AND PARENTS:

Each Students and his/her parents/ guardian shall have to furnish an affidavit along with the application from to the effect that they/ he will not participate in or abet the act of ragging and that, if he/they found guilty, shall be liable for punishment under the penal law of India.

WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING:

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- I. Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness with a fresher or any other student.
- II. Indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- III. Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- IV. Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- V. Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- VI. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- VII. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;



- VIII. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- IX. Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

RAGGING: PUNISHMENTS

The University Grants Commission vide its letter no F.1-16/2007 (CPP-II) dated June 17, 2009 has reiterated the ban on ragging of students in Institutions of Higher Learning.

- I. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- II. Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- III. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- IV. Withholding results.
- V. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- VI. Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.
- VII. Cancellation of admission.
- VIII. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- IX. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- X. Fine up to 25,000/
- XI. Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.
- XII. The students therefore strictly directed to desist from any kind of ragging.


